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Overview

- Each year CAUS members are requested to submit an Institutional Self-audit and Statistics Reporting Form in addition to their yearly membership dues.
- Data submitted by CAUS members from 2011 through 2015* has been compiled to support the statistics in this presentation.



*Note: While each year some CAUS members are remiss in submitting their dive statistics, we are expecting more members to submit their 2015 stats shortly after the 2016 CAUS AGM.

Question 1

Between 2011 and 2015, the number of member institutions registered with CAUS grew from _____ to _____?

2011: 10 Members

Which region has the highest number of member institutions registered with CAUS?

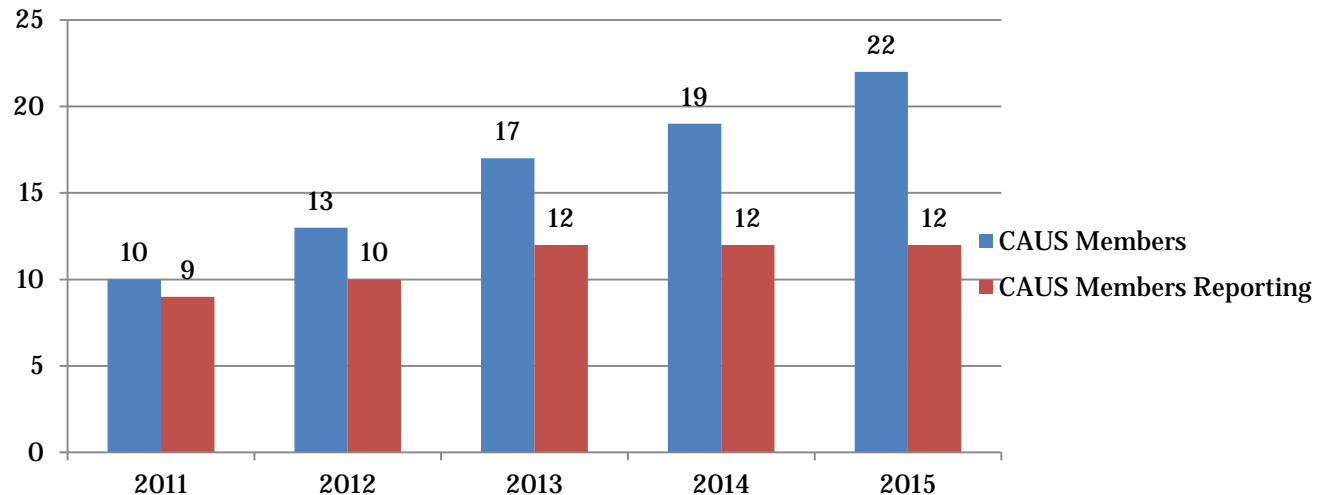

Question 4

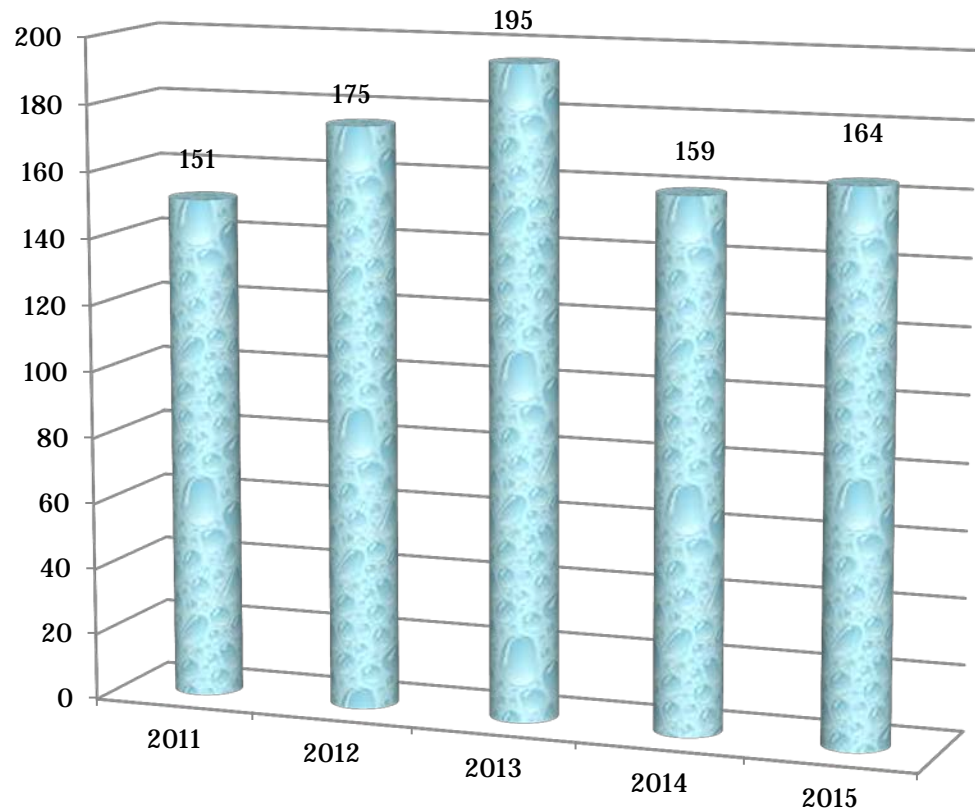
What is the highest number of scientific divers from all CAUS institutes recorded in any year between 2011 and 2014?

*Note: Once all dive stats are reported for 2015, it is expected that the total number of divers for this year may exceed 195.

ANSWER:

21088 dives

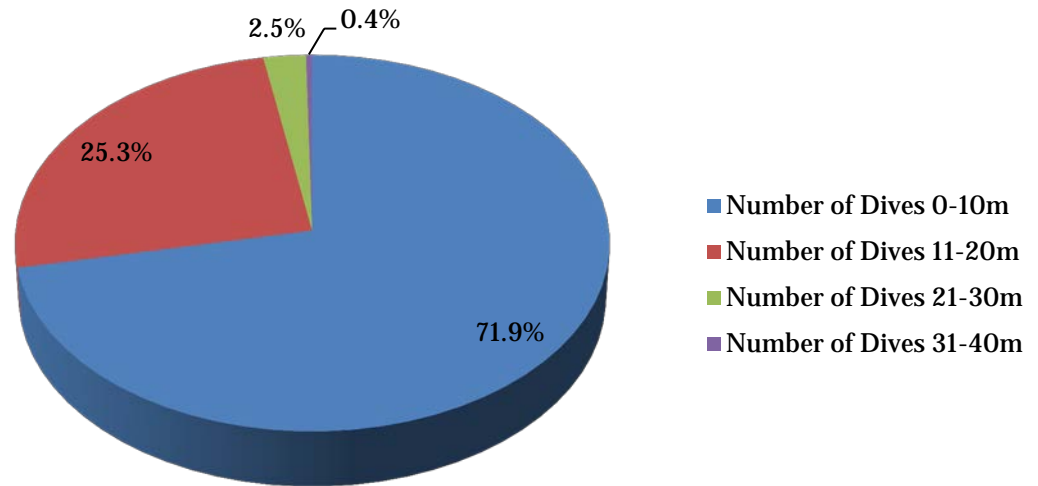


Question 6

Based on Question 5, what is the overall percentage of dives distributed between the categories below?

ANSWER:

- a) 41-50m: 0% (Example)
- b) **0-10m: 71.9%**
- c) **11-20m: 25.3%**
- d) **21-30m: 2.5%**
- e) **31-40m: 0.4%**



Pie Chart – used JUST for Torbyn!

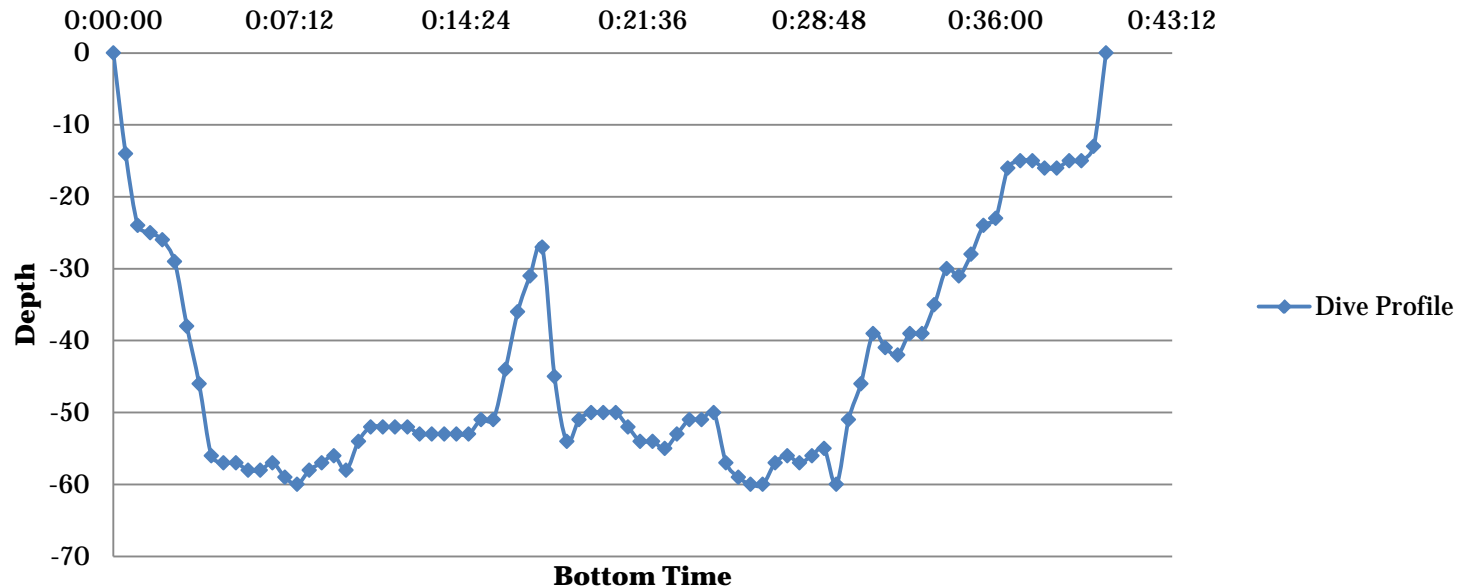
Question 7

What is the total bottom time reported since 2011?

ANSWER: 973686 mins

= (16228 hrs + 6 mins) = (676 days + 4 hrs+6 mins)
